

About Chorlton Players...

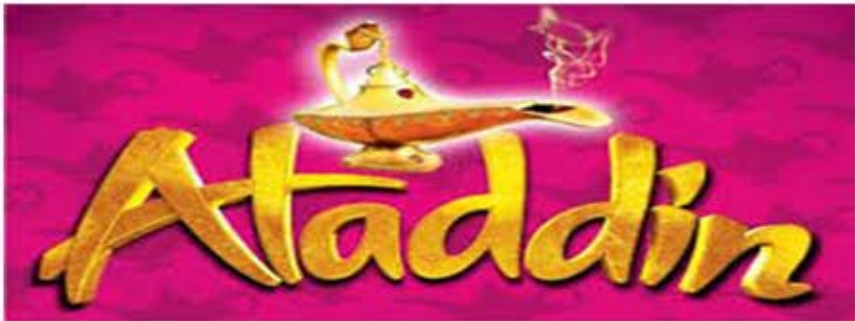
